Definitions

- Post-Consumer Material generated by households or by commercial, industrial, and institutional facilities in their role as end-users of the product that can no longer be used for its intended purpose. This includes returns of materials from the distribution chain
- <u>Pre-Consumer</u> Material diverted from the waste stream during the manufacturing process. Excluded is the reutilization of materials such as rework, regrind or scrap generated in a process and capable of being reclaimed within the same process that generated it.

• Certified Recycled Content Percentage Scope

- GRS products must contain a minimum of 20% certified recycled content. For products with 20-94% certified GRS content, choose GRS (20-94%). For products with 95-100% certified GRS content choose GRS (100%). GRS Logo can only be used on products with minimum 50% certified recycled content.
- RCS products must contain a minimum of 5% certified recycled content. For products with 5-94% certified RCS content, choose RCS (5-94%). For products with 95-100% certified RCS content choose RCS (100%). RCS 100% must contain a minimum of 95% certified recycled content.
