**Personalized Inspections –** IDFL uses the Acceptance Quality Limit(AQL) or client designated standards. Based on the actual conditions, IDFL will consult with the clients to ensure that the inspection system does not inadvertently allow a high failure rate for non-compliant units, in order to improve quality consistency and reduce costs.



**Problem Solving** – IDFL will aid manufacturers in identifing and solving the origin of product defects so that non-compliant units will not reoccur.



**Customized Sampling** – IDFL also provides recommended sample sizes based on historical data. If a factory consistently has failures, the sample percentage is increased. If the factory progressively increases quality, sampling percentages are decreased according to historical pass/fail rates.



**Flexible Reporting Options –** IDFL customizes reports for each customer, providing visualized information and numerical data in the reports.

### **Quality Inspection Process**

IDFL provides inspection services on behalf of clients to confirm that imported products have been manufactured according to specifications and labeling standards.

## Pre-Production Inspection (PPI)

As part of the Pre-Production Inspection, an IDFL inspector will work with the factory employees to make sure that they understand the product specifications before products are made.

## Initial Product Inspection (IPI)

The Initial Product Inspection will help verify that the factory not only understood the product specifications but that the first few products coming off the line are being built according to specifications.

#### During Production Inspection (DUPRO)

When a shipment is less than 80% complete, IDFL will go into the factory and perform a DUPRO to ensure that the products meet the expected quality. Our inspectors will randomly pull samples from the shipment to inspect, and errors will be recorded and reported. The random testing method will help companies know whether the shipment meets quality standards.

## Final Random Inspection (FRI)

When a shipment is 100% complete and at least 80% packaged, an FRI can be performed to ensure that the products meet the expected quality. Our inspectors will pull samples randomly from the shipment to inspect, and errors will be recorded and reported to you. This will help a company know that the shipment is meeting quality standards before it leaves the factory.

#### 100% Inspection

When needed, IDFL can perform a 100% inspection to verify that the entire shipment meets specifications.
